EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF ENCLOSED COMMUNICATION: EARPA, the Estheticians Advanced
Research Projects Agency, is exploring options for reorganization under U.S.
Government Shutdown no.17/2013(a). The EARPA Board convened on 05 October 2013
to discuss the possibility of merging overseas intelligence operations with an
affiliated U.S.Department of Defense organization CARPA, the Craft Advanced
Research Projects Agency. Such a restructuring would not be without precendent,
and would be carried out in strict compliance with the 1997 Toledo Accords.

Dear Director Lung

AS United States Department of Defense (D.O.D.) funding reaches a historic low point, and its budget appears to be at risk of further reduction, EARPA has been forced to place over half of its civillian staff, including many sub-agnecy research contractors, on furlough.

In considering the possibility of complete dissolution by the D.O.D. our agency has begun to undertake a proactive approach to ensuring our agency's survival. Thus, we are reaching out to a select group of affiliated agencies in hopes of arranging joint missions which will reduce costs. We hope that this partnership will support a continued future for advanced research project agencies.

We hope that you will recognize the common ground shared by CARPA and EARPA. Our agencies are jointly concerned with the material aspects of the feminine sphere which have been historically undervalued by the patriarchical Western industrial military complex of which we are a(crucial, even essential, I would argue) part.

As a first step, assuming your complicance, we have enclosed a project for which we solicit your help.

The enclosed briefcase and corresponding objects were seized by TSA officials on 26 September 2013 at JFK Airport from an aircraft bound for Dubai, and ultimately for Karachi PK. The TSA passed this confisqued item to our investigations research department in Trenton, NJ. We believe it holds the key to revealing a deadly weapon of unknown power, code-named "Toiletry", but have been unable to extract further information from the enclosed materials. Thus we seek your expertise in paint-based materials knowledge.
